MISSION STATEMENT

The charter organizer, Nueva Esperanza's (NEI) educational mission prepares students in grades Kindergarten through twelve to meet the challenges of living creatively and productively in an increasingly technologically sophisticated and interconnected world. The mission is a result of over 30 years of working in and with the North Philadelphia and Latino community. Community residents (defined by those who live in 19140) have been plagued by a 48% graduation rate, households with an adjusted gross income of \$23,489 (2012), and 64% below or 50% below the poverty line. Under/unemployment and inadequate/interrupted education have created significant barriers in achieving lifelong success. NEI initially sought to address issues that are known causes of systemic poverty and under-education by applying for a cyber school charter, which was approved in 2012 as Esperanza Cyber Charter School (ECCS). Since September 2012, over 2,000 students have passed through the school and 116 have graduated, where ECCS touched their lives during the charter term helping to break the cycle of poverty and under-education through its educational mission preparing them to find a successful path from school to college or career.

VISION STATEMENT

Drawn from principles reported in the well-regarded study on Latino youth and education, Why Some Schools with Latino Children Beat the Odds, and Others Don't the school philosophy includes:

- Every member of the school maintains a clear focus on student outcomes; we believe that all children can be successful in school and life.
- Through the use of multiple metrics and continuous assessment of growth and factors that inhibit growth those analyses will inform the development of individualized instruction; we believe in data telling the story of improved outcomes as the ending.
- The school leader maintains a strong focus on student success; we believe in leadership that pushes forward regardless of barriers or obstacles in the home.
- Accepting that every effort is tried until it fails, and every failure informs success; we believe that the consistent message of every eye on student outcomes will show progress.

Strengths

38% of students improved their total scale score by at least one point in reading/language arts from their first test to their last test.

21% of students moved from the top of the red to between the middle of the green ranges (below to on-grade level) on the CDT ELA exams showing a reasonable amount of growth.

10% of our students moved from green to blue ranges on the CDT tests showing significant amounts of growth.

A reasonable amount of the achievement gap was closed for 7% of students whose reading/language arts scores reflect reasonable or significant growth by meeting or exceeding the SEM growth goal on the Full CDT exams.

Challenges

Academic proficiency for all groups but especially for English learners and students with disabilities targeting improvements in small group discussions around math problems to improve word problem-solving skills and to add more supported vocabulary instruction to improve reading comprehension.

One of the challenges at ECCS is the transient nature of our students who come to our school for a year and then choose a new school. A reasonable amount of the achievement gap was closed for 19% of students whose math scores reflect reasonable or significant growth by meeting or exceeding the SEM growth goal on the Full CDT exams.

The new curriculum taught with fidelity this year has improved classroom attendance and overall passing rates.

One of our key strengths lies in our ability to have open discussions in the name of continuous improvement. The school uses a team approach with voices from all roles within the school.

Upon enrollment all high school students meet with the high school counselor to develop a four-year graduation plan to meet the school's graduation requirements.

Counselors provide instruction in college, career, and community goals to enhance opportunities for personal growth and to formulate post-secondary plans.

Full-time Spanish speaking paraprofessional to support EL learners in and out of the classroom.

The ability of our teachers to conduct lessons with an online delivery. Many are now experienced cyber educators with more than three years of experience. The school offered a dual-language Newcomer program this year for the English learner who had little to no English-speaking skills. This program is expected to expand over the upcoming year to provide support and services to more students in WIDA levels 1 and 2 that will better prepare the child for English language acquisition and transition into regular education classes with supports.

Most team members agree that we collectively shape the vision, provide frequent feedback, and continuously monitor progress. Although operational teaching staff wants this initiative to continue and improve by adding more opportunities to differentiate observations, evaluations, feedback, and follow-through.

On the Q3 administration of the 21-22 SY ELA IXL assessment, 18.3% of students in grades K-5 scored at/above grade level and 3.2% in grades 6-12 scored at/above grade level, which did not meet the Q3 targets for ELA.

On the Q3 administration of the 21-22 SY Math IXL assessment, 18.9% of students in grades K-5 scored at/above grade level and 0.1% in grades 6-12 scored at/above grade level, which did not meet the Q3 targets for math.

One of the challenges that ECCS encounters relates to the transitory nature of the school. Students who stay at the school experience academic success through high school graduation. On the other hand, students who stay at our school for a year or less, do not experience as much academic success. As ECCS continues to grow in enrollment and number of retained students, the academic growth and graduation rates are expected to increase.

ECCS struggles with a very transient population. Many students have a school history involving multiple school changes. Many students arrive after orientation and mid-year. Many students leave throughout the year. Implementing a PBIS program can improve data, systems, and practices that will positively affect

retention, attendance, and student outcomes.

A team of stakeholders should work on whatever curriculum revisions are necessary to ensure that most staff can report that curriculum enhances their efforts to meet state standards. Implementing practices in small groups focused around before, during, and after reading strategies along with an increased focus on targeted vocabulary instruction to support language acquisition could improve comprehension on criterion-referenced assessments.

Continue to improve and mature our system of positive supports to offer the greatest possible interventions to our community, while simultaneously ensuring that students who do not respond to those supports are provided additional assistance and encouragement.

It is suggested that we focus on a more overt campaign of student support services in academics while also better publicizing all of the non-academic interventions that have been implemented and continue to evolve in a positive manner.

As reported in the 2021 Future Ready PA Index (FRPAI), the 4- and 5-year graduation rate for 2019-2020 was 45.7% and 62.7% respectively (Graduation is reported as lagging indicator in the FRPA, one year behind).

Challenges

Although some did show improvement in ELA scores, just not enough reasonable growth to be considered to close the achievement gap with significance. Implementing practices in small groups focused around before, during, and after reading strategies along with an increased focus on targeted vocabulary instruction to support language acquisition could improve comprehension on criterion-referenced assessments.

On the Spring 2022 ELA IXL Assessment, only 9.4% of K-5 Students with IEPs performed at grade level, compared to 18.3% of K-5 student overall.

Although we have a strong curriculum with credentialed teachers our EL students are not making as much progress as their regular education peers. Implementing the SIOP model within instructional practices along with an increased focus on targeted vocabulary instruction to support language acquisition could improve comprehension on criterion-referenced assessments.

The MTSS program is newly implemented in 2019-2020 and needs further evaluation with revisions, additions, or modifications to close the achievement gap quicker for EL learners and students with disabilities. Continue to improve multi-tiered systems of support to increase daily and class attendance and provide individualized and targeted reading and math interventions to those in need. Also offer the greatest possible interventions to our community, while simultaneously ensuring

that students who do not respond to those supports are provided additional assistance and encouragement. Additional opportunities to implement a multi-tiered system of supports that more effectively help students improve math and reading skills are being explored for the upcoming school year. Implementing a PBIS program can improve data, systems, and practices that will positively affect retention, attendance, and student outcomes.

Most Notable Observations/Patterns

It is evident through data analysis that all students are below grade level in both ELA and math, including English Learners and Students with IEPs. There is a need for opportunities targeted professional learning, coaching and collaboration focused on building the capacity of staff to use assessment data to provide tiered supports to scaffold and differentiate instruction and intervention to significantly improve student achievement and growth. To that end, there is a need to provide tiered supports to improve engagement and attendance.
